After reviewing the announcements of the last week and what scenarios we could possibly do, FCS will be finishing the year by the online school.

The last day for online instruction for the preschool, elementary and middle school will be Thursday, May 14. Please remember the students will have until Sunday night to complete the work.

The last day of instruction for the high school will be Tuesday, May 19. All work for the high school we need turned in online by Wednesday, May 20. There will be no exams for the high school this year.

The last material/assignment drop off day for the elementary will be Monday, May 18, from 5-8 PM. We are also asking that any library books that the students have be returned at this time. This will also be a pick-up time for any items that have been left in the classroom by the students. The teachers will bag these items up, and it will be available out front when the students drop off their assignments.

On Thursday, May 21, there will be a drop off time from 5-8 PM for the middle school and high school students. Students will be dropping off any textbooks that they have at home, library books, ball uniforms or any other items that need to be returned to the school. Students will also be picking up items that they have left in their lockers. Teachers will be packing up anything in their lockers, and it will be available out front when the students drop off their books.

If you have not registered your children for school next year by FACTS, we are asking that you do that as soon as possible. We typically enroll in March of each school year. We delayed it this year because of the coronavirus situation. At this point, it is important that we be able to plan for the next school year. You can help us do this by taking care of the enrollment process which is done through FACTS. If you're having problems with this process or have questions on this process, please call the school office. If we're not here at the time, please leave a message and we will return your phone call.

K-5 graduation – information will be coming out to the K-5 class

JR/SR – information will be coming out to the juniors and seniors
